

Photographic and Filming Policy -
LSERSA 2026

We are committed at LSERSA to provide a safe and secure environment for children and young people whilst in our care. We wish to celebrate and document those achievements of our young people through the use of photography and filming. The use of such media must be created responsibly and with respect for the privacy and safety of our participants.

At LSERSA we will :

Promote the safe use of images and videos via our website and social media channels.

Adopt safeguarding best practice if any concerns arise through code of conduct by staff and volunteers.

Allow authorised staff and photographers to take photographs and videos at LSERSA run events, ensuring the correct vetting procedures are followed, storing images securely and limiting access to authorised individuals only.

Use images and videos for the limited purposes of training, promoting and celebrating our organisation.

Acknowledge the wish of parents to take photographs or film their own children but ask that parents do not take photographs or film other children without the consent of their parents.

Immediately deal with any concerns parents may have in regard to the public taking persistent photographs or video at an event. Please report this to the Welfare Officer immediately.

Take all steps to ensure all images are used solely for the purposes they are intended. If anyone becomes aware that these images are being used inappropriately you should inform the Welfare Officer immediately.
